- Continually consider new programs and adjustments.
- Review program sites for small group activities for distancing space.
- Continually review procedures with OHS and adhere to provincial restrictions.
- Engage community through the process.
- Consider possible adjustments to budget due to Covid-19.
- Reconsider any paid programming.
- Use this as an opportunity to provide new services.

Build the narrative the summary ... the story:

As restrictions for Covid-19 change we need to be prepared to transition our service delivery to provide recreation programs under updated guidelines. Under current restrictions we will continue to develop alternative delivery methods and be intentional about planning for future scenarios, with special attention given to adjustments of current programs and development of new ones that can be integrated into our normal service delivery.

Special consideration of our geographic challenges and further increase of socio-economic challenges due to effects of Covid-19, we need to adapt our delivery accordingly.

Action Plan:

- Develop workplans for each scenario and continually review and assess as restrictions change.
- Adjust student hiring needs and process for the summer.
- Purchase safety and cleaning equipment.
- Develop back to work plan for the department.
- Adjust Marketing and communications strategy.
