This award honours a person or community group that promotes the positive values of recreation. It highlights their strong leadership, programs, activities, and services that benefit individuals and the community socially, economically, and environmentally.

Submissions will be evaluated using the following criteria:

<p>The Shared Strategy for Advancing Recreation in Nova Scotia identifies eight values and operating principles: inclusion and equity; public good; sustainability; lifelong participation; outcome-driven; quality and relevance; evidence-based; and partnership and collaboration.
