Submissions will be evaluated using the following criteria:

Is the cooperation or collaboration between two or more community groups and/or local governments evident and well described?	Scoring /15
Are the new/innovative programs, policies, services, or activities evident and well described?	Scoring /10
Is there evidence that healthier futures through active lifestyles will result from this initiative?	Scoring /10
Do testimonials from someone who has benefited directly from programs, policies, services or activities that resulted from the nominees' work demonstrate the recreational values and benefits achieved/promoted by the collaboration?  Are there links to media coverage or other support materials that may help reviewers?	Scoring /5
