Director-at-Large, Student Nomination Process

As per its By-Laws, Recreation Nova Scotia (RNS) has a Board of Director's position available to students studying within the field of recreation in Nova Scotia. This is a full voting position that is nominated by students at Acadia, Dalhousie, Nova Scotia Community College – Truro Campus, and Cape Breton University and elected by the RNS members in attendance during the Annual General Meeting. This is a one-year, volunteer position.

Nomination Process

1. Application must be sent for review to RNS Nominations Committee – deadline August 31, 2018
2. An application from a student will include three components
 - [] the Board Application Form (available on website)
 - [] the Call for Nominations Form (available on website); and
 - [] at least one Reference Letter supporting the candidate's application
3. The Nomination Committee will review applications, screen and interview nominees and make recommendations.
4. In addition, the usual process of nominations from the floor of the Annual General Meeting will be pursued. The AGM will take place on October 26, 2018 at Oak Island Inn and Resort
5. If there is more than one nominee, each candidate will be given two minutes to address the membership. If the nominee is not present another student can read the prepared speech of the absent student nominee.
6. In case of nominations from the floor, if elected, the candidate must pass the RNS Board screening policy before assuming office.
7. If not self nominated, the Nominee must have completed the *Nominee Acceptance Form* (see Application).
